Call for abstract:

Participants are invited to submit abstracts on the themes of the conference and may mail their abstracts at sdcofp2024bkbihepilani@gmail.com by March 28, 2024. The abstracts should be within the limit of 350-500 words in English font 'Times New Roman' with size '12'. Title should be informative, specific and short, not exceeding 25 words, first letter should be capital. The title should be followed by name(s) of the author(s) in bold. Affiliation should be written in italics, centered and of 10 font size. While sending the abstract, the author should mention the theme area above the title in Times New Roman (Font size 14 bold). After receiving the abstract, an acknowledgement letter will be sent to the author with the registration number. The number should always be quoted while making further enquiry about the publication. The confirmation for acceptance will be communicated within 5-6 days. The abstracts will be released in 'Abstract Book' on April 12, 2024 during inaugural session of the conference. Selection of abstract for full length paper, oral or poster presentation will be made separately and intimated accordingly.

Call for paper:

The full length paper should be within 3000 words in English font 'Times New Roman' with size '12'. All the full length papers will be screened for originality and will be reviewed by conference reviewer team. Selected papers may be considered after peer review in the edited book. Authors may be requested to revise the manuscript according to the Book or journal guidelines. All the accepted papers will be published in the conference proceedings with ISBN No. in the form of e-book.

Poster presentations:

Participants are requested to prepare their posters within the prescribed dimensions. The poster size should be 2×3 feet (width x length). The poster should be prepared as per following headings: Theme area, Title, Authors' names, Affiliation, Abstract, Key words, Introduction (Brief), Materials and Methods, Results and Discussion, and Conclusions.
